- Taking notes based on a text, with the mental map method.
- Knowing how to read a mental map.

Hands-on work: Creating multiple mental maps for individual training. Sharing, debriefing, and findings about each person's practices.

3) Using mental mapping to increase your productivity

- Knowing where to start, overcoming blank page syndrome.
- Developing collective intelligence: Working in groups with a single mental map.
- Leading a multi-person meeting with a collective mental map.
- Creating a communicable summary and encouraging feedback without grades.
- Writing up an action plan and daring to innovate.
- Memorizing without effort, making a speech dynamic and lively.

Hands-on work: In sub-groups: Creating a manual map and using it as a basis for a collective oral presentation. Individual and group debriefing.

4) Creating mental maps with the software XMind

- Overview of different software and creating mental maps.
- Discovering XMind: The fundamentals of mental mapping.
- Building a digital mental map: Structure, theme, branches, etc.
- Laying out a mental map: Font, size, colors, images, tags, etc.
- Reorganizing and modifying an existing mental map.

Exercise: Creating mental maps on a PC with the software XMind.
